

TUITION ASSISTANCE

FINANCIAL AID OPTIONS ARE AVAILABLE TO ALL ST. ROSE FAMILIES WHO QUALIFY

St. Rose tuition is determined annually upon recommendation by the School Finance Committee.

Tuition Discounts

Parish Scholarship - \$700 family discount: Families who are certified by the pastor of their Catholic parish as active in that parish will receive a tuition discount. Criteria include Mass attendance, financial support and service.

Service Hour Discount - \$500 family discount: Families who complete the required 25 hours of service within the school and parish community during a year are eligible for a \$500 tuition discount the following year. New families who agree to complete service will receive the discount their first year.

Multi-Child Discount - Families with more than one child at St. Rose automatically receive a multi-child discount built into the schedule of tuition.

Tuition Assistance

St. Rose Tuition Assistance is based on financial need and is made possible with funding by the Baldocchi Scholarship Fund, the Knights of Columbus, the Eileen Schneider Tuition Assistance Fund, the Aquinas Scholarship and other benefactors. Family participation in school and parish is a strong consideration in awarding assistance. Eligibility for tuition assistance requires financial obligations be current.

- All families who request tuition assistance must apply each year with FAIR-Financial Aid Independent Review-at www.fairapp.com.
- 2022 income tax returns must be provided with your application.
- Application period is February 1st through April 18th

The BASIC Fund scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis to families who fall within low-income guidelines based on the federal Free or Reduced Price Lunch Program, for students entering private school for the first time, in Preschool through 8th grade. This tuition assistance is renewable annually through 8th grade.

- Deadline is March 31, 2023.
- Renewing families will receive their information from BASIC by Feb. 6th.
- Renewing families who are applying for a new sibling must submit a new application by the March 31 deadline.
- Renewing families will receive a renewal LINK via email by Feb. 6th.
